



Annual Show and Sale 2017

St John's Garden Centre

Saturday 5th August 2017 10.00am – 4.00pm

Once again, St Johns have kindly offered to host our annual show and sale. We need a large number of entries for the competitions which will be judged during the show (cash vouchers to be won!), and also plenty of items for sale. There were a lot of visitors last year, and many items of members' work were sold. It's an ideal opportunity to show off your skills and help fund your turning.

There are five competition classes and you may enter up to three items in each class for which you are eligible, **though no-one can win more than one prize**. Whether for entry for the competition or for sale, all your items must be identified as described below on a small label stuck to the underside of the item (for small items or, for example, fruit, on the side near the bottom). The label **must** contain the following information:

- The 2-character **MAKER'S CODE** (see the list overleaf);
- The **CLASS** entered (1,2,3,4 or 5) or S for items for the sale stand only;
- **ENTRY number** 1, 2, 3 for the competitions. **ITEM letter** A,B,C etc (no limit) for the sale stand;
- **PRICE (in multiples of 50p only please)**, or **NFS** if any competition items are **Not For Sale**.

No variation in identification can be accepted.

You will **also** need to submit separate lists (see the two attached forms) of

- a) your competition entries (**if to be offered for sale – no price limit**)
- b) your items for the sale stand (**no price limit**)

15% commission will be charged on all items sold, to offset the club's expenses.

There will be prizes (cash vouchers) for the Winner and Runner-up in each of the FIVE classes, which will be:

Class 1 - Novice	Open to any member who has never won a prize in a NDWT competition. Any turning.
Class 2 - Intermediate	Open to any member <u>except</u> those who have won a prize in a NDWT competition <i>above the Novice class</i> in the previous 4 years. Any turning.
Class 3 - Novelty	Open to any member. Any novelty item. <i>In addition to the winner's voucher</i> , the winning entry could be the trophy awarded to the following year's Novelty Class winner*.
Class 4 - Advanced	Open to any member. Any turned item with a natural edge.
Class 5 - Master	Open to any member. A wooden candelabra of any size and design which must conform to the following basic criteria: Freestanding, a central candleholder with three, matched, symmetrically-placed, candle-holding branches.

The entries in all classes will be assessed by the judges under four headings;

1 Degree of Difficulty 2 Design 3 Craftsmanship 4 Finish

The scores under all headings will be totalled and the prize winners will be announced during the show.

If you wish, entries for the competitions may be sold following the judging (*except the Novelty Class winner).

We also need as many members as possible to volunteer for a short period of duty on the day (rather than a few members toiling for hours on end). If you are available, please contact David Pepper.

There will also be a Tombola. Please bring one or more tombola prizes, which should be wooden, preferably your own work and worth at least £5, either to the July meeting, or to the show itself before 10.00am.

PLEASE BE SURE TO BRING YOUR ENTRIES FOR THE COMPETITIONS, SALE STAND AND TOMBOLA AFTER 9.00am AND NO LATER THAN 10.00am ON THE MORNING OF THE SHOW

We will do our best to keep your pieces safe, but the club cannot accept responsibility for any losses or breakages.
